SOCIETY ACT

VANCOUVER UNITED FOOTBALL CLUB CONSTITUTION

- 1. The name of the Society is **VANCOUVER UNITED FOOTBALL CLUB**.
- 2. The purposes of the Society are:
 - (a) To continue the heritages of the Dunbar Soccer Association, Kerrisdale Soccer Club, the Point Grey Soccer Club and any future Club joining the Association;
 - (b) To promote the game of soccer in the neighbourhoods and communities of the City of Vancouver;
 - (c) To form male and female soccer teams and to enter those teams in organized leagues at the appropriate level of play;
 - (d) To provide facilities and equipment to optimize the development and enjoyment of players;
 - (e) To encourage sportsmanship, fair play and a sense of community through participation in soccer;
 - (f) To provide for an exchange of ideas relating to the game of soccer;
 - (g) To provide leadership, guidance and co-operation with other societies and organizations to promote the development of the game of soccer; and
 - (h) To enforce the Articles, Bylaws and Policies of the British Columbia Soccer Association.
- 3. The Directors shall serve without remuneration, and the directors shall not receive, directly or indirectly, any profits from their position as Directors but may be paid expenses incurred by them in the performance of their duties.
- 4. The Society shall be carried on without purpose of gain for its member(s), and no part of any income of the Society shall be payable or otherwise available for the personal benefit of the member(s) thereof and any profits or other accretions to the Society shall be used for promoting its purposes.
- 5. Upon wind-up or dissolution of the Society the assets remaining after the payment of all costs, charges, and expenses properly incurred in the wind-up, including the remuneration of a liquidator, after payment to employees of the Society of any arrears of salaries or wages, after

payment of any other debts of the Society, and provided the association is constituted exclusively for charitable purposes, the assets of the Society will be distributed to:

- (a) firstly, to one or more Vancouver based soccer associations;
- (b) secondly, to the British Columbia Soccer Association;
- (c) thirdly, to a charitable organization or organizations in British Columbia having a similar charitable purpose to that of the Society; or
- (d) fourthly, to a registered charity or charities in British Columbia as defined by the Income Tax Act (Canada) from time to time, as determined by the members of the Society at the time of winding-up or dissolution.
- 6. The Society shall be constituted exclusively for charitable purposes.
- 7. Clauses 3, 4, 5, 6, and this paragraph are unalterable.
